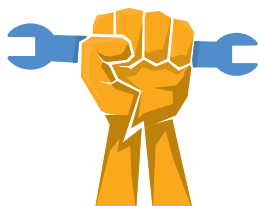

TRAVELERS' Safety Tips

- There is a daily purchase limit of \$500.00 and an ATM daily limit of \$200.00 - unless you request a temporary limit raise.
- Many rental companies and hotels will place a hold for several days on your card, which will reduce the amount available for other purchases.
- Always carry more than one source of payment in case your card is stolen or flagged by the fraud department.
- Make sure your cell phone number is listed as your contact number on your card. In the event the fraud department does lock your card, they will be able to contact you while you are traveling.
- Any time you travel outside of your normal area, please let us know- this will keep your card from being locked due to suspected fraud.
- If the number 612-492-8369 calls you, ANSWER, this is our Fraud Prevention Services. They are calling you to report suspicious activity on your account. Until you approve or deny the transactions, your card will be temporarily blocked. In the event you missed their call, you may call them back at 1-866-842-5208 or call the Credit Union at 903-785-6682.
- Most importantly, when Fraud Prevention Services asks for information or questions whether information is correct, you will never be asked to give enough information which could compromise your account.
